## CONTRACT FOR SECURITY SERVICES

## KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This contract for security services and entered by and between:

The FERTILIZER AND PESTICIDE AUTHORITY (FPA), formerly an attached agency of the Department of Agriculture and transferred to the Office of the President pursuant to Executive Order No. 165, with postal address at FPA Building, BAI Compound, Visayas Ave., Diliman, Quezon City represented by its Executive Director, DR. NORLITO R. GICANA, herein referred to as the CLIENT.

and

STAR SPECIAL CORPORATE SECURITY MANAGEMENT, INC. a private security agency duly authorized and existing under the laws of the Philippines with office address at No. 140 J.P. Rizal Street, Project 4, Quezon City, herein represented in this Contract by its President ATTY. EDGARDO C. SORIANO of legal age, married and a resident of # 42 Narcissus St., Roxas District, Quezon City, hereinafter referred to as the CONTRACTOR.

## WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the CLIENT desires to engage the services of the CONTRACTOR for the purpose of safeguarding the lives of its employees while in the performance of their duties in their places of work, and of guarding and protecting its properties and its office at the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI) Compound, Visayas Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City from theft, pilferage, robbery, damage and unlawful acts of strangers;

**WHEREAS**, the CONTRACTOR, who represents to be a duly authorized security agency, with capital, facilities and men adequate to provide the security needs of its client, is willing to enter into a contract with the CLIENT for the aforementioned purposes;

- 1. The CONTRACTOR shall provide the CLIENT with the following:
  - a. Three (3) licensed, uniformed, bonded and armed with
     .38 caliber security guards;
  - b. One (1) unit Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) complete with One (1) unit Monitor, One (1) unit DVR and Eight (8) units Camera;
  - c. One (1) metal detector, emergency and first aid kit;
  - d. Raincoat, rain boot, umbrella and emergency light.

Each guard shall render security services for an Eight (8) hours duty including Sundays and Holidays;

- 2. The CONTRACTOR warrants that every security guard assigned under this Contract possesses with the following qualifications:
  - a. At least, he must be college level;
  - b. Of good moral character, and reputation without criminal records;
  - c. Physically and mentally fit and not less than Twenty-three (23) years old nor more than Forty-five (45) years old, and
  - d. He must be duly licensed by proper authorities.

- 3. For and in consideration of the services to be rendered by the CONTRACTOR, the CLIENT shall during the life of this Contract, pay the CONTRACTOR the sum of *Sixty-two Thousand One Hundred Thirty-six & 81/100 Pesos Only (P62,136.81)* a month for Twenty-Four (24) hours duty for Three (3) guards, Eight (8) hours per duty or a total of *Seven Hundred Forty-five Thousand Six Hundred Forty-one & 72/100 pesos Only (P745,641.72)*, for one year. All accounts shall be paid by the CLIENT to the CONTRACTOR every Fifteenth (15) day upon presentation of semi-monthly invoices of billing without need of demand.
- 4. The CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for payment of the benefits of its security guards provided by law such as SSS, PhilHealth and Pag-IBIG premiums and shall submit the contribution/remittance report of the same to the CLIENT as proof of compliance thereof prior to the issuance of the succeeding payments;
- 5. The CONTRACTOR may negotiate with the CLIENT a revision of stipulated contract price in the event that the minimum wage is increased or fringe benefits for security guards is provided by law, executive or wage order;
- 6. The CONTRACTOR reserves the right to terminate this Contract for non-payment of overdue account for THIRTY (30) days. The CLIENT is hereby also given the option to terminate this Contract for violation of the terms by sending a written notice of termination to the CONTRACTOR Thirty (30) days prior to the effectivity of the termination;
- 7. The CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for the losses or damages of all properties of the CLIENT including those held in trust which are located within the compound of the CLIENT, except those enumerated in the subsequent paragraph, during the tour of duty of the guards of the CONTRACTOR. The CONTRACTOR shall be informed in writing of such losses or damages within Forty-Eight (48) hours from the time of occurrence due to negligence of the security guard on duty;
- 8. The CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for any losses or damages to the property of the CLIENT whether or not there is a clear showing that any door or window or other point of entries were subjected to force. In such event, the CONTRACTOR shall be liable to replace the value of the loss or damaged property and the amount shall be automatically deducted from the agreed salary of the guard/s concerned;
- 9. The CONTRACTOR shall not be liable for losses and/or damages on the following situations:
  - a. Fortuitous events or force majeure;
  - b. Order of the CLIENT beyond the scope of this Contract;
  - Any property of the CLIENT which is entrusted/issued to its employees unless the same is turned-over to the custody of the security guard for safeguarding;

- d. Any property of the CLIENT within the premises which were not turned-over to the security guards for safeguarding and safekeeping;
- e. For any losses or damages to any permanent fixture, when such loss or damage is due to the fault of its employee; and
- f. The property of the CLIENT which are placed in open storage which were not turned-over to the security guards. In the case the same is turned-over to the CONTRACTOR, the same must be properly inventoried in the presence of the representatives of the CLIENT and the CONTRACTOR and recorded in the log book.
- 10. The CONTRACTOR shall exercise disciplinary, supervisory and administrative control over its guard in accordance with law, rules and regulations laid down by the CLIENT for the effective performance of the security guard on duty;
- 11. The CONTRACOR may request the CLIENT in writing to adopt necessary security measures which shall be specified in the request, and to be agreed by the parties;
- 12. The CLIENT reserves the right to reduce or increase the number of security guards as the exigency of the operation requires. In the event that the CLIENT loses its trust and confidence of any of the security guards assigned by the CONTRACTOR, the CLIENT may at any time ask in writing for the immediate replacement of the security guard concerned; and
- 13. This Contract shall take effect beginning August 01, 2014 to July 31, 2015 unless cancelled or terminated by either parties upon serving a thirty (30) days written notice, but all rights of claims which may have been accrued to either parties prior to date of termination, shall be respected.
