**REQUEST FOR QUOTATION**

The Fertilizer and Pesticide Authority, through its Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), invites interested parties for the:

**Procurement of Transport, Treatment and Disposal of  
One (1) lot hazardous laboratory waste  
Budget for the Contract (ABC): Php 220,000.00**

**Technical Specification:**

- 1.) Service Provider must be and/or must use an accredited Transporter and/or Treatment, Storage and Disposal (TSD) facility at the Environmental Management Bureau of the DENR.
- 2.) Service must cover the transport, treatment, and disposal of the following wastes (in metric tons) including all necessary documentations:
  - a. B202 (Hydrochloric acid) – 1.7200
  - b. C301 (Caustic soda – 2.3200
  - c. D403 (Barium and its compounds) – 0.0850
  - d. D405 (Chromium compounds) – 0.0500
  - e. D407 (Mercury and mercury compounds) – 0.0200
  - f. D499 (Other wastes with inorganic chemicals) – 0.0800
  - g. G704 (Non-halogenated organic solvents) – 0.2000
  - h. J201 (Containers previously containing toxic chemicals) – 0.0300
- 3.) Upon receipt of the Job Order from the Fertilizer and Pesticide Authority (FPA), the Service Provider shall coordinate with FPA in securing a Permit to Transport (PTT) from the DENR through its online Hazardous Waste Manifest System.
- 4.) The Service Provider shall be responsible in the proper collection, transportation, treatment, and disposal of FPA's hazardous wastes. Manpower necessary for the hauling shall be provided by Service Provider. If the Service Provider/s DENR permit authorizes collection and transportation of hazardous waste alone, the Service Provider shall ensure that the treatment and disposal of the hazardous wastes shall be performed by its affiliate company with a valid permit issued by the DENR. The service provider and/or its partner DENR-accredited Treatment, Storage and Disposal (TSD) Facility, shall defend, indemnify and hold the FPA, its officers and employees free from any claims, losses, liability costs and expenses or any suits for injury to any person (including contractors or its employees), damage to or loss of property or any other claims arising out of or resulting from gross negligence or any material act or omission of its personnel/employees, agents or subcontractors in the performance of the aforementioned activities.
- 5.) The hazardous wastes shall be collected from FPA Central Office with supervision of FPA's Pollution Control Officer and transported to the Service Provider's treatment facility within the agreed schedule between the PCO and the Service Provider.
- 6.) The Service Provider shall provide the DENR-accredited transport vehicle and container to collect the laboratory wastes from FPA.

7.) Upon mutual agreement between the PCO and the Service Provider, the schedule of collection shall be determined and carried out.

**Terms and Conditions:**

1. Quotations received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected during its opening.
2. Suppliers must submit their duly accomplished and signed Price Quotation, together with valid **PhilGEPS Registry Number, Mayor's Permit, and Omnibus Sworn Statement** to the FPA-BAC. Submission sent on at the BAC official email-address, [fpa.bac@gmail.com](mailto:fpa.bac@gmail.com), will also be accepted if received prior to the deadline.
3. All quotations must be submitted to the BAC Secretariat, through **Mr. Angelo S. Bugarin** and **Ms. Mirasol O. Bacarisas**. Deadline of submission of quotations is on **November 15, 2021, 5:00 p.m.**
4. All quoted items must be VAT inclusive.
