The herein Supplemental Bulletin No. 1 is issued to inform all prospective suppliers for the Fuel Requirement for FY 2021 (via Fleet Card Services) of the following changes in the Notice of Negotiated Procurement, to wit:

Issues and Concerns Raised	FPA-BAC Response
1. Deletion of the term "Rebid"	Approved the deletion of the term "Rebid." The procurement has undergone two (2) failed biddings the reason why the BAC resorted into Negotiated Procurement under Section 53.1 of R.A. No. 9184. Likewise, the BAC will not be issuing Bidding Documents, as the terms and conditions for this negotiated procurement is already stipulated in the Notice of Negotiated Procurement and Technical Specifications.
2. Deletion of Part 2 and 3 of the Notice of Negotiated Procurement	Approved the deletion as these parts were only applicable for Public Bidding.
3. Reiteration of the requirements to be submitted by the supplier	Each supplier must submit their proposal together with: a. Compliance to the technical specifications b. Certificate of PhilGEPS Registration c. Mayor's Permit d. most recent Annual Business Tax Return
4. Conduct of Opening of Proposal	Opening of submitted proposals will be on January 12, 2021, 10:00 A.M. at the 4th Floor, Board Room, FPA Bldg. The supplier may opt to attend virtually provided the proposal they submitted was received by the BAC Secretariat on or before the deadline of submission. The online platform that will be used by the FPA BAC is Zoom and the link will be provided to those suppliers who requested it via e-mail at fpa.bac@gmail.com .

5. Changes on the Technical Specifications	1. Estimated supply of petroleum products for eleven (11) months must be based on the prevailing pump price during the transaction period. 3.C.iv. Product restriction (type of fuel, lubricants, other services; allocation and frequency of services); and 4. Billing will be done on a monthly basis based on the actual consumption of the registered FPA service vehicle.

This Supplemental No. 1 is issued and adopted as amendment and made an integral part of the Notice of Negotiated Procurement pursuant to Solicitation No. **NNP-2020-12-01**.
