MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE GUIDELINES ON THE TRAINING AND SYMPOSIUM TO BE MANAGED BY THE FPA ACCREDITED TRAINING ASSOCIATIONS

In the interest of the service, the following guidelines on the training and symposium to be managed by the FPA Accredited Training Associations (FATA) are hereby amended.


- I. Section 4.5.5, items C.1.2 and C.1.3 of the Pesticide Regulatory Policies and Implementing Guidelines are hereby amended as follows:

“The FATA can manage the conduct of symposium with multiple topics such as ARCO, Agricultural CPA (Exterminator and Fumigator), and Fertilizer and Pesticide Researcher provided they can align the topics and get experts as resource speakers. In doing so, the FATA can accept attendees with accreditations similar to the topics in the symposium. Further, the topics with brief descriptions and the curriculum vitae of the resource speakers shall be submitted to FPA two weeks before the date of the symposium.”

- II. Item I.1 of FPA Memorandum Circular No. 14, series of 2020 is hereby amended as follows:

“There will be no limit in the number of participants for the online training and symposium. In case of group attendance wherein the participants shall be lodged in one room, the FATA shall ensure that the health and safety protocols are followed.”

This Circular takes effect immediately and supersedes previous Issuances inconsistent herewith.
