**SUBJECT: RECONSTITUTION OF THE EVALUATION AND MONITORING TEAM  
FOR THE FORTIFIED ORGANIC FERTILIZER DEVELOPMENT  
PROGRAM (FOFDP)**

In view of the implementation of the Fortified Organic Fertilizer Development Program (FOFDP), the Fertilizer and Pesticide Authority (FPA) is hereby amending the Special Order No. 32 Series of 2021 entitled: *Reconstitution of the Evaluation and Monitoring Team for the Fortified Organic Fertilizer Development Program (FOFDP)*. The FPA Evaluation and Monitoring Team for the said program is hereby reconstituted:


1. Suzettie M. Alcaide - Supervising Agriculturist, Regional Field Unit (RFU IV)
2. Jayar V. Rivera - Agriculturist I, Pesticide Regulations Division
3. Rowena C. Reyes - Supervising Agriculturist, Fertilizer Regulations Division
4. Mark Nicky S. Larga - Agriculturist II, RFU IV
5. Leonardo A. Bangad - Supervising Agriculturist, RFU II
6. Romeo Val R. Suguitan Jr. - Supervising Agriculturist, RFU IV

The function of the team shall be as follows:

1. Assess the eligibility of the LGUs which applied as a potential beneficiary of the program based on the approved criteria under Office Order 15, series of 2021 and the Checklist and make recommendations.
2. Ensure the successful establishment of the composting facilities and the proper liquidation of the transferred funds by the selected LGU-beneficiaries.
3. Conduct orientation and training on the selected beneficiaries.
4. Monitor and visit the facility at least once every quarter.
5. Conduct a periodic random sampling of compost for laboratory analysis.
6. Monitor, document and validate the progress of the program implementation as well as the production data and overall sustainability of the CFBW operation.

As such, the above-mentioned personnel are authorized to claim their expenses such as transportation costs, per diem, honorarium, and other incidentals that might be incurred upon performance of their functions, chargeable against the FPA funds, subject to usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
