## B. Terms of Reference for PRTE

1. Review and evaluate data submission for Product Registration/Experimental Use Permit (EUP), particularly on the following:
  - a. Specification
    - Product Composition
    - Chemical and Physical Properties
    - Technical and Formulation Analysis
    - Production Process
  - b. Biological Efficacy
    - Efficacy of pesticide products in terms of crops/pests being applied for
  - c. Toxicology, such as:
    - Acute toxicity
    - Short term and long term studies
    - Special studies, e.g. pharmacokinetics, mutagenicity, breakdown products, teratogenicity, reproductive studies, carcinogenicity
  - d. Human Exposure and Safety
  - e. Residue, Environmental Fate and Transport, such as:
    - Effects on wildlife and other non-target organisms
    - Residue on food and in the environment
    - Degradation studies
    - Mobility and accumulation studies

As such, the PRTE shall be entitled to the approved rates of honoraria provided under Annex "A", chargeable against the FPA funds, subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations and availability of funds.

This Order shall be valid from January 1, 2022 up to December 31, 2022.
