FORM OF IMPORT/EXPORT PERMITS AND CLEARANCES
THROUGH THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL SINGLE WINDOW

This refers to the Advisory Letter of Commissioner Rozzano Rufino B. Biazon of the Bureau of Customs (BOC) that "effective 25 February 2013, the BOC shall impose that only cargo import/export permits and clearances in electronic form through the Philippine National Single Window (PNSW) will be accepted at the NAIA ports." The BOC is now phasing out the use of paper permits and clearances in the processing of import/export permits/clearances as part of the BOC clearance procedures.

In view thereof, FPA will only process import/export permits/clearances in electronic form. For those who have not yet register with the PNSW, you are hereby enjoined to register in the PNSW website: <a href="https://nsw.gov.ph">https://nsw.gov.ph</a>. to facilitate the processing of all import/export permits/clearances of fertilizer and pesticide and avoid any unnecessary delay.

Attached is a copy of BOC Memorandum Order "Guidelines in the Tagging of e-Permits/Clearances of Import/Export Cargoes through the Philippine National Single Window".
