Each of the twenty (20) mango growers and flower inducers who participated in the activity were provided with an attendance certificate on GAP Training on Mango, which was signed by Dir. Wilfredo C. Roldan.





Witnessing the Updating of Pesticide's Shelf Life

November 5, 2021

The FPA team headed by Deputy Director for Pesticide Mr. Eric C. Divinagracia, Ms. Marrisa G. Napalit (Regional Officer), and the rest of the team witnessed the imprinting of the updated shelf life of pesticide products.



These pesticides have undergone laboratory analysis, reassessment of its active ingredient's efficacy and its stability before the reprinting. If the pesticide can pass the procedure and present a certificate of the reanalysis and other supporting documents from FPA-related laboratories, it will be available for reselling from a specific company. Once a pesticide is allowed for reselling, a new expiration date will be printed on the same label.

Executive Meeting with Industry Players

November 5, 2021

FPA 11 and Croplife Phils. Regional Action Team (CRAN XI) conducted an exclusive meeting with the Deputy Executive Director for Pesticide Mr. Eric C. Divinagracia in Davao City.

Some of the topics discussed included extensive guidelines on the expiration of pesticide products, refreshing the knowledge and know-how on the MOA labelling market, and clear and precise guidelines on the disposal and retrieval of empty pesticide containers from end-users during the meeting.



November 5, 2021

Mula, Deputy Director on Fertilizer, graced the DAREMANCOM 2021 Performance Evaluation and FY 2022 Integrated Work and Financial Plan Preparation Workshop, chaired by DA-CAR OIC-Regional Director Dr. Cameron P. Each agency, including FPA-CAR, presented its accomplishments and targets categorized per DA as One Program's 18 strategies under the four pillars – consolidation, modernization, industrialization, and professionalism. FPA Region X discussed with the dealers of Misamis Oriental the reasons affecting the price increase of fertilizers last November 9-10.

FPA-Bicol attends the RCEF-RFFA

November 11, 2021



Mr. Gabriel B. Atole, FPA-Bicol Regional Officer, attended the Rice Competitiveness Enhancement Fund – Rice Farmers Financial Assistance (RCEF-RFFA) Launching Ceremony & Awarding of Various Interventions held at the Albay Astrodome in Legazpi City on November 11, 2021.

Department of Agriculture Secretary William D. Dar and DA-RF05 Regional Executive Director Rodel P. Tornilla led the ceremony.

During his speech, Sec. William D. Dar cited the reasons for the continuous increase in the price of fertilizers: 1) Big agricultural countries such as Brazil and India made an advance booking of fertilizer to meet their domestic demand. Further, China has allocated their local fertilizer production for their domestic use, resulting in reduced fertilizer exports to the Philippines; 2) Increase in freight cost affected by COVID-19 logistical issues and restrictions; and 3) High cost of raw materials used to produce fertilizers, such as natural gas.

Hence, to mitigate the impact of high prices of inputs to farmers, the Department of Agriculture is promoting the Balanced Fertilization Management Strategy to address problems on land degradation and decline in soil fertility through adjustments in the cropping and management of farming systems by means of cover cropping of short duration leguminous crops and introduce non-traditional fertilizers, and the microbial/biorational fertilizers.

November 11, 2021

Last November 11, FPA Regional Officer Mr. Alex Paalisbo served as the Resource Person at the 107th Regular session of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in the Province of Zamboanga del Sur. This is to bring attention to the developing difficulties confronting the agriculture industry, particularly the ongoing rise in fertilizer and agricultural input prices. He also emphasized that the international market was a factor in these challenges, and he offered suggestions for mitigating their effects.

Board Member Saniel also underlined the necessity of soil analysis in determining the exact and adequate amount of fertilizer to apply on each farm and the function of organic farming practices in producing fertilizer for farmers.

Ms. Lindley Herrera, the OIC-Provincial Agriculturist discussed how the scarcity of fertilizer supplies is causing the price increase.

Michael Tuico, FPA provincial officer, and representatives from the FPA were also in attendance.



November 12, 2021

The Board of Directors of the Regional Tripartite Wages and Productivity Board - Caraga, which includes the Department of Technology and Information (DTI), the National Economic Development Authority (NEDA), the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), and the Department of Agriculture, held a virtual meeting last November 12 with the FPA Caraga.



FPA Caraga explained the rapid spike in Traditional/Imported fertilizers during the virtual conference.

The Regulatory Division of DA-CAR, headed by Mr. Ruben Dulagan, organized and funded the activity. A random sampling of vegetables was brought to the Benguet Agri-Pinoy Trading Center at La Trinidad. It will start by the year 2022. This is to establish baseline data to be referenced by DA and concerned agencies like FPA in the planning and implementation of programs and activities to ensure food quality. However, the RTK is limited to the detection of organophosphates and carbamates.


