**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 017**

**SUBJECT : SUBMISSION OF PROPOSED MRL & PRE-HARVEST INTERVAL  
OF ALL REGISTERED PESTICIDE PRODUCTS**

Pursuant to Section 6, III (2) and (4) of Presidential Decree No. 1144, in order to protect the public from potential hazards of pesticide residues on food, FPA is mandated to establish a system of maximum residue levels (MRL) applicable for both domestic and imported raw agricultural commodities.


Consistent therewith, as part of the continuing program to generate baseline data for the establishment of Philippine National Standards (PNS) for MRLs, all pesticide companies are hereby required to submit the proposed MRL, PHI, and the approved use pattern for each and every pesticide product that they have registered with FPA.

To facilitate the consolidation of all submissions, the required data shall be tabulated in a spreadsheet (preferably *Microsoft Excel*) as follows and shall be submitted to FPA through [fpa.prd@gmail.com](mailto:fpa.prd@gmail.com). Deadline of submission is on January 10, 2020.
